Schedule by periods will be released at a later date





- Seniors MUST return to Karcher Center to return gown and sign for their diplomas

Graduation dress code



- White graduation gown zipped up
- SOLID white dress
- White/off white, or nude colored shoes
 - Heels, pumps, wedges, or a fancier sandal with back strap
- White mortar board with white hairpins
- 2022 Red and Gold tassel
- ONLY cords, medals and/or stoles received at Senior Awards
- The Rosary medallion they received at Baccalaureate

NOT PERMITTED: Leis, necklaces, non-Rosary stoles, dangling earrings, boots, booties, flip flops, sunglasses, gum, corsages, cell phones, headphones, or water bottles (provided under chairs).

Cap and Gown

- Students should have been sized last Wednesday 3/2 or Friday 3/4
 - Check to make sure your daughter has done that. If she was absent, please have her see Mrs. Huerta for gown fitting
- She MUST bring her cap and gown to graduation
 - Clean and ready to wear!
- She must turn in her gown after the ceremony in order to receive diploma
- Gowns returned by 7pm campus closes at 7:30pm

- Seniors will each receive 8 tickets for the graduation ceremony.
